WEIGHTS: NCAA Women's Weights: 103, 110, 117, 124, 131, 138, 145, 160, 180, 207, & 235

SKIN CHECK: Will be done in the weigh-in area, prior to weigh-ins. Skin checks are at 6:40 am and must be completed in order to weigh-in.

WEIGH-IN: Held in the Cerritos College Gym at 7 am on Saturday, February 7th.

Please submit entries by Thursday, February 5th, at 8:00 p.m. PST. You may drop and add wrestlers and change weight classes prior to the close of registration. Walk-up registration will be accepted. However, registration will close 15 minutes before weigh-ins.

FORMAT: This tournament will be a double-elimination event conducted on 3–4 mats. Bracket formats will vary depending on the number of athletes in each weight class. There will be no seeding; brackets will be created using separation criteria. The tournament will feature 11 weight classes. The top six placers in each weight class will receive medals, and the top three teams will be awarded trophies. A Most Outstanding Wrestler (OW) will be selected at the conclusion of the finals. Each head coach will receive one vote for OW. Team scoring will be calculated based on the highest-scoring wrestler in each of the 11 weight classes.
